WHEREAS, Bradley County executed a Disaster Management and Recovery Professional Services Agreement with Thompson Consulting Services, LLC on May 1, 2020 (hereinafter “County Disaster Management and Recovery Contract”); and

WHEREAS, the term of the County Disaster Management and Recovery Contract provides for ninety (90) days of professional services on the part of Thompson Consulting Services, LLC; and

WHEREAS a copy of the County Disaster Management and Recovery Contract is attached herein for reference; and

WHEREAS, the County Disaster Management and Recovery Contract provides comprehensive disaster debris monitoring services, emergency management planning and training services, and damage assessment and reconstruction services to include, without limitation, project management for debris removal and disposal sites; cost accounting for reimbursement by state and federal agencies; and mobilization of debris removal personnel, equipment, and subcontractors; and

WHEREAS, as a consequence of the County Disaster Management and Recovery Contract and the County’s other emergency and support resources, the County has the authority and capacity to extend debris removal services and disposal site services to municipal governments within the boundaries of Bradley County where such services are required following a state of disaster, imminent threat of disaster, or state of emergency declared pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated § 58-2-107; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality desires that the County perform debris removal services within the Municipality’s corporate boundaries and disposal site services on behalf of the Municipality following a declared state of disaster, imminent threat of disaster, or state of emergency; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement does not apply to streets and highways within the Municipality’s corporate boundaries that are under the sole authority of the Tennessee Department of Transportation

(hereinafter “TDOT”), except for TDOT streets and highways within the Municipality’s corporate boundaries that TDOT has delegated responsibility for debris removal services to the Municipality.

THEREFORE, BRADLEY COUNTY, TENNESSEE, by and through its County Commission (herein the “County”) and the CITY OF CLEVELAND, by and through its City Council (herein the “Municipality”) hereby enter into this Agreement this ____ day of May, 2020.

ARTICLE 1

PURPOSE AND AUTHORITY FOR THE AGREEMENT

The purpose of this Agreement is to establish an Undertaking, as herein below defined, by the two units of local government who are parties to this Agreement. County and Municipality are authorized to enter into interlocal agreements pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated § 12-9-104.

ARTICLE 2

DEFINITIONS

For purposes of this Agreement, the following definitions shall apply:

2.1 “Agreement” – shall mean this Disaster Management and Recovery Interlocal Agreement.

2.2 “County” – shall mean the County of Bradley County, Tennessee.

2.3 “Municipality” – shall mean the municipal government of Cleveland, Tennessee.

2.4 “Undertaking” – shall mean debris removal services and disposal site services performed by the County on behalf of the Municipality as provided herein.

2.5 “Municipal Corporate Boundaries” -- shall mean the corporate boundaries of the Municipality to include its extra-territorial jurisdiction boundaries.

ARTICLE 3

DURATION OF THE AGREEMENT

The duration of this Agreement shall begin upon adoption of this Agreement by the County and the Municipality and shall exist and be effective for ninety (90) days or until the County’s Disaster Management

and Recovery Professional Consulting Agreement with Thompson Consulting Services, LLC expires or is terminated, whichever is less.

ARTICLE 4
AMENDMENTS

This Agreement may only be amended by the written consent of the County and Municipality.

ARTICLE 5
TERMINATION

This Agreement may be terminated upon thirty (30) days written notice from the County or Municipality.

ARTICLE 6
COUNTY OBLIGATIONS

The County agrees to:

6.1 Assume responsibility for debris removal and disposal services within the corporate boundaries of the Municipality following a state of disaster or state of emergency supported by a Presidential Declaration that allows for federal reimbursement of storm-generated debris removal and disposal.

6.2 Monitor and document the amount of debris removed from within the corporate boundaries of the Municipality during such state of disaster or emergency.

6.3 Produce all necessary documentation to state and federal agencies for reimbursement of storm debris removal and disposal services performed within the corporate boundaries of the Municipality.

6.4 Produce to the Municipality all necessary documentation showing the Municipality's share of any debris removal or disposal costs not reimbursed by state or federal agencies. The calculation of non-reimbursed debris removal operations will be determined by the actual volume of non-reimbursable material collected within the corporate boundaries of the municipality based on documentation generated by County monitors at the time debris is delivered to County-designated collection sites.

6.5 Pursue the Undertaking in accordance with all applicable Federal, State and local

laws and regulations.

6.6 Ensure Thompson Consulting Services, LLC, its, agents, representatives, and successors, deploy haulers in an equitable and proportional manner to serve each participant of this Interlocal Agreement, according to the scope of debris that is identified for removal.

ARTICLE 7

MUNICIPALITY OBLIGATIONS

The Municipality agrees to the following:

7.1 Cooperate with the County in its production of a debris removal and disposal plan, participate in all training exercises related to storm debris removal, and supply appropriate administrative support, as necessary, to assist in the documentation of debris removal/ disposal efforts.

7.2 Reimburse the County the Municipality's share of any debris removal or disposal costs not reimbursed by state or federal agencies. The calculation of the Municipality's reimbursable cost to the County will be determined by its share of the actual volume of material collected within the corporate boundaries of the municipality based on documentation generated by County monitors at the time debris is delivered to County-designated collection sites.

7.3 Pursue the Undertaking in accordance with all applicable Federal, State and local laws and regulations.

A county medical examiner shall be a physician who is either a graduate of an accredited medical school authorized to confer upon graduates the degree of doctor of medicine (M.D.) and who is duly licensed in Tennessee, or is a graduate of a recognized osteopathic college authorized to confer the degree of doctor of osteopathy (D.O.) and who is licensed to practice osteopathic medicine in Tennessee, and shall be elected from a list of a maximum of two (2) doctors of medicine or osteopathy nominated by convention of the physicians, medical or osteopathic, resident in the county, the convention to be called for this purpose by the county mayor”; and

WHEREAS, appointments to the position of medical examiner are for a five (5) year term with eligibility for reappointment by the county mayor with confirmation by the county legislative body; and

WHEREAS, the Bradley County Mayor nominates Dr. Jerry J. Coleman, DO to be appointed Bradley County Medical Examiner pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated § 38-7-104.
