Dear Mr. Wolf:

Earlier this week, the Bradley County Commission voted unanimously, at the recommendation of our Road Committee, to request that a traffic study be conducted at the intersection of State Route 312/Harrison Pike, Freewill Road NW, and Harris Creek Trail SW. The request emerged as many of us have received calls and emails from area residents voicing their concern for the safety of the intersection. The intersection, equipped with a yellow caution beacon, has become an increasingly busy and hazardous junction. Vehicle traffic from hundreds of nearby homes and Prospect Elementary School has increased as a result of significant residential development.

The Bradley County Commission shares your desire to safely, effectively, and efficiently move people about our community. We believe an assessment of the intersection is the first step in mitigation. We are hopeful your study will provide options to improve the intersection to limit the potential loss of life or serious injury. We respectfully request your assistance in examining our issues with this intersection. We, the local governmental leaders, stand ready to assist throughout the study process and are confident that together we can better protect our community.

COUNTY COMMISSION VACANCY 5th District Seat B

Timeline

- * August 25, 2019 - Notice of vacancy

- *September 23, 2019 – Announce October 21, 2019, date to fill seat 5B
Accept applications through October 14, 2019. Resumes will be forwarded to each Commissioner upon receipt and a file containing hard copies of all resumes received will be given to each Commissioner on October 14, 2019.

- *October 6, 2019 – News announcement of meeting to fill seat 5B

- *October 21, 2019 – Meeting to fill seat 5B
Candidates will have 2 minutes to introduce themselves to the Commission and explain their interest in filling the seat. Commissioners will nominate with voting to ensue.

- *April 2, 2020 – Deadline to declare for August 6, 2020 race
Per state statute the appointee will serve until a successor is elected at the next countywide general election on August 6, 2020.

- *August 6, 2020 – General election to fill seat 5B

- *September 1, 2020 – Seat 5B sworn into office

- *Term expires August 31, 2022

Information and Requirements

- *Vacancy must be filled within 120 days of notice of vacancy

- *Public notice must be given news notice at least 7 days prior to the meeting at which the seat is filled

- *Registered voters may submit names for consideration.

- *Only Commissioners may nominate a person for consideration.

- *Voting on nominations – the first nominee to receive 7 votes will fill the unexpired seat 5B term. Should there be more than one nominee, the nominee receiving the least number of votes will be removed from consideration. The other nominees will advance to the next round of voting. Voting will continue until a nominee receives 7 votes.
