Chairman Louie Alford called the meeting to order.

Following the Pledge of Allegiance led by Commissioner Johnny Mull, Living Word Church Associate Pastor Neil Thomason prayed the invocation.

REPORT FROM COUNTY MAYOR

County Mayor D. Gary Davis introduced Rich Kienlen to provide the workhouse monthly report. Kienlen reported the workhouse received 13 referrals in December including three from child support. December revenue, including state inmate revenue, local working inmates and rent, totaled \$105,000. Kienlen added workhouse revenue since opening in August totals \$437,586.75. Kienlen reported there are currently 74 state inmates and 14 local working inmates in the workhouse. Mayor Davis responded approximately \$250,000 to Commissioner Thomas Crye's question for the annual workhouse bond payment.
