2015-56 authorizing Mayor to negotiate and enter into a contract with Alex Vaughn d/b/a River City Athletic Field regarding the Elrod Park infield mix installation for an amount of \$97,750 (11.2.2015) PASSED

2015-57 requesting the General Assembly of the state of Tennessee to amend Chapter 19 of the private acts of 1991, as amended by Chapter 66 of the private acts of 2004, on behalf of Bradley County to increase the hotel/motel privilege tax from 5% to 7% of the consideration of charged by the operator and to alter the allocation of percentages from the proceeds of said hotel/motel privilege tax (11.2.2015) PASSED

2015-58 authorizing Mayor to execute a one year contract with Cigna Health and Life Insurance Company from January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016, to provide health insurance benefits for Bradley County employees offering 3 options to employees at a cost of \$518.75 per month for each employee enrolled (11.2.2015) PASSED

2015-59 authorizing the issuance of general obligation refunding bonds of Bradley County in the aggregate principle amount of not to exceed \$5,675,000 in one or more series; making provision for the issuance, sale and payment of said bond, establishing the terms thereof and the disposition of proceeds therefrom; and providing for the levy of taxes for the payment of principle of, premium if any, and interest of the bonds (11.16.2015) PASSED
