- Cleaning clogged outlets
- Mowing dry pond embankments
- Clearing sediment, trash, and debris from channels or forebays.
- Repair and replace eroded soil and vegetation

Non-Routine Maintenance

This includes, but isn't limited to:

- Remove sediment build up
- Treat or remove invasive vegetation
- Repair or replace broken or ineffective outlet structures
- Repair or replace riprap in order to prevent erosion
