## **RESOLUTION 2021- RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A REDISTRICTING COMMITTEE**

**Whereas**, Tennessee Code Annotated (T.C.A.) Section 5-1-111 requires that at least every ten (10) years, county legislative bodies shall change the boundaries of county legislative districts so that members represent substantially equal populations; and

**Whereas**, the Bradley County Commission created by resolution 2011-36 a redistricting committee that was later dissolved by motion on September 4, 2012; and

**Whereas**, the Bradley County Legislative Body finds it to be in the best interest of Bradley County to establish a Redistricting Committee to assist the Bradley County Legislative Body with the necessary boundary changes to the county legislative districts so that members represent substantially equal populations.

**Now, therefore, be it resolved by the** Bradley County Legislative Body meeting in regular session on the 6<sup>th</sup> of July, 2021, that:

**Section 1:** The Bradley County Legislative Body does hereby establish a Redistricting Committee to prepare suggested redistricting plans to be presented to and voted on by the entire Bradley County Legislative Body.

**Section 2:** The Redistricting Committee shall include a representative of each County Commission district and includes the following members:

- (1) Commissioner Mike Hughes
- (2) Commissioner Thomas Crye
- (3) Commissioner Milan Blake, Chairman
- (4) Commissioner Charlotte Peak
- (5) Commissioner Cindy Slater
- (6) Commissioner Erica Davis
- (7) Commissioner Bill Winters
- (8) Election Administrator Fran Green

**Section 3:** Meetings of the Redistricting Committee shall be subject to the open meeting provisions of T.C.A. Title 8 Chapter 44.

**Section 4:** The Redistricting Committee shall meet from time to time as necessary in order to prepare suggested redistricting plans. The chair of the Redistricting Committee shall report to the Bradley County Legislative Body at the first meeting of the Bradley County Legislative Body each month on the status of suggested redistricting plans.

**Whereas**, Jeff Yarber tirelessly supported the law enforcement community during his tenure on the Bradley County Commission by continuously and vigorously advocating for funding to ensure the public safety of our residents by providing the Sheriff’s Department with adequate staffing, training, equipment, and technology; and

**Whereas**, the naming of this command center is an appropriate recognition for a strong law enforcement advocate; and
