REPORT FROM COUNTY MAYOR

County Mayor D. Gary Davis presented updated fiscal year 2021-2022 budget books to the Commission.

Mayor Davis presented to the Commission a resolution fixing the tax levy for Bradley County, Tennessee, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021. Commissioner Milan Blake placed the resolution on the July 6, 2021, voting session agenda.

Mayor Davis presented to the Commission a resolution fixing the tax levy of the county fire district of Bradley County, Tennessee, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021. Commissioner Blake placed the resolution on the July 6, 2021, voting session agenda.

Mayor Davis presented to the Commission a resolution making appropriations for the various funds, departments, institutions, offices and agencies of Bradley County, Tennessee for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2022. Commissioner Blake placed the resolution on the July 6, 2021, voting session agenda.

Mayor Davis presented to the Commission a resolution making appropriations to non-profit charitable organizations of Bradley County, Tennessee, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021, and ending June 30, 2022. Commissioner Blake placed the resolution on the July 6, 2021, voting session agenda.

Mayor Davis presented to the Commission a resolution authorizing Bradley County Mayor to negotiate and enter into an agreement with B&W Contractors, Inc. d/b/a Cherokee Construction Company to provide front canopy repair services for the Bradley County Sheriff's Office for an

amount of thirty-seven thousand four hundred ninety-six dollars (\$37,496.00). Commissioner Cindy Slater placed the resolution on the July 6, 2021, voting session agenda.

Mayor Davis presented to the Commission a resolution authorizing Bradley County Mayor to negotiate and enter into an agreement with Montgomery Technology Systems, LLC to provide upgrades to the existing perimeter security camera system for the Bradley County Sheriff's Office for an amount of one hundred eight thousand dollars (\$108,000.00). Commissioner Slater placed the resolution on the July 6, 2021, voting session agenda.

Mayor Davis presented to the Commission a resolution authorizing the Bradley County Mayor to execute an interlocal agreement with the City of Cleveland for records management services for a period of three (3) years. Commissioner Slater placed the resolution on the July 6, 2021, voting session agenda.

Mayor Davis announced sixty-two thousand four hundred seventy-five (62,475) Bradley County residents have received the Covid-19 vaccine. Mayor Davis reported there are currently twenty-six (26) active cases of Covid-19 in the county.
