REPORT FROM COUNTY MAYOR

County Mayor D. Gary Davis presented to the Commission for consideration a resolution authorizing Bradley County Mayor to enter into a five (5) year lease agreement with Larry S. McDaniel and Coy D. Keck for continued use by the Bradley County Trustee's Office and Bradley County Clerk's Office of approximately 3,733 square feet of office space and a drive-thru located at 1701 Keith Street NW in Cleveland, Tennessee for a rate of forty-eight thousand dollars (\$48,000.00) per year. Commissioner Milan Blake placed the resolution on the August 7, 2023, voting session agenda.

Mayor Davis reported the RC&D managed septic program has resulted in eighty-nine (89) contracts and sixty-two (62) completions and the in-house septic program has resulted in eighteen (18) contracts and four (4) completions.

Mayor Davis confirmed the Student Resource Officer grant funds have been received.
