RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING SIXTY THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED TWENTY FIVE DOLLARS (\$60,625.00) FOR THE SIM GOODWIN ROAD WATER PROJECT IN BRADLEY COUNTY TO CLEVELAND UTILITIES AS ALLOWED BY THE CONDITIONS AND TERMS OF THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FROM THE FUNDS ALLOCATED BY RESOLUTION 2021-50 AND AUTHORIZING THE BRADLEY COUNTY MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH CLEVELAND UTILITIES REGARDING SAID APPROPRIATION

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2021, the United States Congress passed the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 ("ARPA"), which provides fiscal relief funds to State and Local Governments, and other program areas aimed at mitigating the continuing efforts of the COVID-19 Pandemic; and

WHEREAS, ARPA is intended to provide support to local governments in responding to the impact of COVID-19 and in their efforts to contain COVID-19 in their communities, residents, and businesses; and

WHEREAS, ARPA includes State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds to support urgent COVID response efforts to decrease the spread of the virus; to replace lost public sector revenue to strengthen support for vital public services; to support immediate economic stabilization for households and businesses; and to address systemic public health and economic challenges that have contributed to inequal impacts of the pandemic on certain populations; and

WHEREAS, Bradley County's allocation is estimated at approximately \$21M; and

WHEREAS, on October 18, 2021, Bradley County adopted Resolution 2021-50 establishing Bradley County's Plan to allocate funds for public water projects as allowed by the conditions and term of the American Rescue Plan Act; and

WHEREAS, on October 17, 2023, the Bradley County Finance Committee voted to recommend accepting the water project for Sim Goodwin Road; and

WHEREAS, Cleveland Utilities has agreed to fund \$20,000.00 of the cost of the water extension project, budgeted at a total cost of \$80,625.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Bradley County Legislative Body meeting in regular session on this 6th day of November, 2023, that sixty thousand six hundred sixty five dollars (\$60,625.00) shall be appropriated for the Sim Goodwin Road Water Line Extension Project to Cleveland Utilities as allowed by the conditions and terms of the American Rescue


Plan Act from the funds allocated on October 18, 2021 by Resolution 2021-50 for public water projects.


